Ensuring Your Compliance and Transparency: Your Annual Reporting Guide:

We are committed to transparency and remind you of your annual compliance obligations. Maintaining tax-exempt status requires meeting key federal and state filing requirements each year. Staying current keeps vital resources flowing to your cause, safeguards donor trust, and ensures the sustainability of your mission.

Key Annual Requirements

- * **IRS Form 990-N (e-Postcard):** Organizations with gross receipts under \$50,000 must file Form 990-N annually with the IRS. This form includes your legal name, address, EIN, and principal officer's name.
- * **Submit Form 990-N by the 15th day of the fifth month after your tax year ends.** For example, file by May 15 if your year ends December 31.
- * **Failure to file for three consecutive years will result in automatic loss of tax-exempt status.** If you are a federally recognized 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization, your primary activities are exempt from federal income tax. However, we are required to report any potential Unrelated Business Income Tax (UBIT) on a separate form (Form 990-T) if you engage in activities outside our core mission that generate significant income.
- * **Share an annual report that highlights your accomplishments, financials, and supporters.** Referencing your Form 990 can further enhance transparency.

Your Role in Our Success

We take compliance requirements seriously. Your continued support helps us maintain the integrity and credibility needed to advance your mission. KMD clients typically begin compliance in January. Contact us to schedule an appointment.
